








# - RAROTONGA -

Bright, vibrant and bustling with energy and excitement, is the island of Rarotonga. Almost completely encircled by reef, and turquoise lagoons, Rarotonga is only 32 km in circumference.

The main township and capital of the Cook Islands, Avarua is the commercial centre of the Country boasting a great selection of shops, banks, cafés and craft stores. The two roads of Rarotonga circle the island, making it difficult to get lost and in the centre of the island is a cluster of high mountain peaks where the highest point is 653 metres. Vehicles can be hired for your convenience or try the local bus which runs daily.

It is most definitely the ideal spot for your romantic or family vacation and with activities galore on both sea and land from mountain hikes, to historic tours, fishing and diving trips to quad bike adventures Rarotonga has something for everyone, of every age.







### Red Sunset Villa







# - AITUTAKI -

The island of Aitutaki, 140 nautical miles north of Rarotonga, is famous for its stunning turquoise lagoon, uninhabited islands and palm-fringed beaches.

Aitutaki has 15 small islets and a main volcanic island with a height of 123 meters; it has a population of approximately 1700. The main island is situated in the northwest of the lagoon, measuring 9km long and 2.5km at its widest point.

The reef around the vast lagoon is 48 km in circumference (the island of Rarotonga would fit inside). The lagoon is surrounded by many tiny islets called motu.

The capital (main village) is Arutanga on the west side of the island and it is also the commercial centre of the Island with shops, banks, cafés and craft stores.

Aitutaki is subdivided in 8 districts. The eight villages are Arutanga, Amuri, Ureia, Reureu, Nikaupara, Vaipae, Tautu and Vaipeka.

Being the second most visited island in the Cook Islands, Aitutaki is served by Air Rarotonga, which offers several daily flights from Rarotonga.

# - SAMOA -






# - PACIFIC PRIVATE JET -

This service is operated as a division of Air Rarotonga and thus offers the highest of operating standards and pilots.

### Aitutaki Private Tour

This new and exclusive day tour to the spectacular Aitutaki accommodates up to 6 people and includes; Private jet flights to and from Aitutaki, VIP transfers on both Rarotonga & Aitutaki.

A private guide will accompany you along with your own personal chef—menu options will be chosen ahead of time. You'll enjoy a lagoon cruise aboard the vaka Titi-ai-tonga before returning to Rarotonga.

The duration of the tour is between 8–10 hours and departure from Rarotonga can be adapted to an afternoon tour with sunset dinner on the lagoon, or to your own requirements.

## Air Rarotonga

The private jet tour experiences to the Northern and Southern Group Islands of the Cook Islands, are well complimented by the National Domestic Airline, Air Rarotonga.

A SAAB 340B+, 34 seat Aircraft provides regular services to the Southern Group Islands, predominantly Aitutaki.

Two Embraer EMB110P1 'Bandeirante' Aircrafts service both Northern and Southern Islands.

The Bandeirante 'Bandit" aircraft can carry 12 passengers throughout the Southern Group, and 8 passengers to the Northern Group Islands.







## Polynesian Pearl Odyssey

In the early 19th Century, European pearl traders were visiting Manihiki to harvest the black lipped oyster shell for the making of Mother of Pearl buttons. One hundred and fifty years later the Williams family of Manihiki began culturing pearls on an organised underwater pearl farm, the genesis of what was to become the local family owned pearl industry on the island.

The Polynesian Pearl Odyssey is a unique journey to Manihiki atoll where you, and your special partner will meet with pearl farmers and see first-hand, how these fabulous gems are cultured in the clear blue waters of the lagoon.

Travel is by private jet—a two hour flight from Rarotonga, and accompanying you will be a concierge and personal chef to attend to every detail of your 2 night—3 day experience, including all meals and activities.

Accommodation is a comfortable loft above a pearl seeding house located right on the lagoons edge. During your stay here you will visit a kaoa (small outcrop housing a pearl seeding platform) and enjoy a picnic lunch surrounded by the vast expanse of one of the South Pacific's pristine lagoons. Snorkel above the pearl farm and watch divers collecting shells for harvest and see how the oysters are seeded.

## Northern Atolls Expedition

From Rarotonga your first stop is Pukapuka. Landing on the southern motu (islet), you will travel about an hour by boat across Pukapuka's lagoon to the main settlement at Wale. Pukapuka has strong community organisation and visionary environmental management practices that have sustained its people for centuries. Explore this fascinating island at your own pace.

Day 2 & 3 has you experiencing the raw beauty, tropical seclusion and authentic island hospitality of Manihiki – home of the Cook Islands black pearl. Here the lagoon is dotted with small structures perched on coral heads, serving as platforms for the seeding of oysters that will, after two years, yield a lustrous south seas black pearl.


Day 4 takes you to Penrhyn, the northern-most island of the Cook Islands, and home to approximately 160 islanders who spend their days fishing, collecting natural golden pearls or weaving exquisite hats and fans from rito (dried coconut fronds). Penrhyn's piercing blue lagoon is breath-taking. If you thought Aitutaki's lagoon was beautiful, wait until you see Penrhyn's.

Day 5 brings you back to Rarotonga.
